Dear Colts and Colt Families,

We are extremely thrilled to welcome you back for the 2020-2021 school year. This year is a new venture for us as we expand from onsite learning to include remote learning and a remote hybrid option. It will be a new and exciting experience for all as we keep the focused goal of enhanced learning at the forefront. The Board of Education recently voted to have the ability to start onsite classes in person and to have our full slate of activities and athletics. While Covid-19 precautions may force these things to look a little different procedurally, we are still pleased to start the return to normalcy.

Included with this letter is a flyer titled "CAMPUS HIGH SCHOOL REOPENING GUIDE 2020-2021", which highlights many of the changes we have had to make due to COVID-19. Please read thoroughly and especially note items below:

- **CLASS SCHEDULE-** For this first semester, we have moved to a plan that puts White Block classes in the first 9 weeks and Black Block classes in the second nine weeks. We did this to allow remote learning to focus on just 4 classes at a time. Having only 4 classes will be helpful in case we are forced by COVID-19 to go school-wide remote. It is our goal return to our normal alternating block in the 2nd semester.
- **STUDENT ARRIVAL –** To maintain safety, we will not open entrances until 7:30 a.m. Students may enter through two designated entrances on the east side, E hall on the west, the bus drop-off entrance, and two entrances from the courtyard. Students are to go directly to their designated class up entry to the school; they may pick up breakfast on the way.
- **FACE MASK REQUIREMENTS-** All students must have and wear a facemask that covers the nose and mouth while at school. Physical distancing and directional travel will be marked and enforced in the hallways.
- **TEMPERATURE CHECKS –** All persons entering Campus High School must have a temperature check upon entrance.

It is extremely important that all persons follow the safety precautions that are in place for COVID-19. While the Board of Education has graciously given us permission to start school in person and allow sports and activities, those things could easily disappear if proper consideration and adherence to the safety protocol guidelines do not occur. It is going to take every single student, staff, and patron to help with this during this time. The sooner we can get and keep local numbers down, the sooner we can return to normal procedures. Never has there been a time where the saying "WE ARE COLT STRONG" has been more applicable and necessary. We must work as a team for this to work. We would greatly appreciate your support and encouragement to your student to make things work so we can be successful.

If you are an upper-class student (10,11,12) who is remote or hybrid, please check your school email over the next week for some important instructions on of the first day. Freshman remote or hybrid students, please look for a separate attachment in this mailing for computer and first day instructions. (Continued on Back)



CAFETERIA PLAN

- Campus High School will have six lunch periods.
- The cafeteria seating area will be extended to include Alumni Hallway.
- The courtyard will be open for students who wish to eat outside. Hand sanitizer will be available at entrances and exits to all eating locations.
- Socially distanced seating for lunches will be mandatory.
- Students are encouraged to sit in the same seat each day.
- To help adhere to social distancing and cross-contamination protocols, students must stay in their seats for the entire duration of lunch.
- Meal choices will be limited and mostly grab-and-go prepackaged.
- Microwaves will not be available. When dismissed, students will be asked to go to their classrooms immediately.
- Restrooms will be available, but monitored, during the lunch period.
- Directional and social distancing signage is placed around the building.



END OF DAY

- All students must be off-premises by 3:15 unless they have explicit permission, are with a teacher, involved in the tutoring program, or are part of an actively meeting club or athletic team.
- Students will not be allowed to form groups inside or outside after school.
- Parents are encouraged to make arrangements to pick up their children by 3:15.
- Students may wait outside until a ride is available if they follow social distancing guidelines.



FRIDAY EARLY RELEASE

- During the fall semester of the 2020-2021 school year, all students will be eligible for Friday early release.
- Buses will remain on their normal schedule.

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EDUCATION PLAN

CLASS SCHEDULE

Campus High School will employ a 4x4 block schedule for the first semester of the 2020-21 school year. Under this plan, students will take their four white day classes and seminar each day during the first quarter and their four black day classes and seminar during the second quarter. The 4x4 block schedule is a temporary measure.



IN PERSON CLASSES

The in-person education and learning option is designed to provide a safe learning environment that is most familiar to most students.

Several measures, outlined on the following pages, are in place to help ensure a safe environment for students.



DISTANCE LEARNING OPTION

The distance learning education model option allows students to learn from home while maintaining a connection to live teachers in real time. Students are required to work six hours per day and to be logged in with a teacher during that time. The hours for distance learning are the same as in-person.



HYBRID LEARNING OPTION

The hybrid learning option is for distance learners who wish to participate in classes that require in-person learning. Classes are very limited and include courses such as woods and auto shop. Core classes such as Math, Science, English, or Social Studies will only be provided in the distance learning format for hybrid students.

FALL REOPENING PROCEDURES



STUDENT ARRIVAL

- Students will not be allowed entrance before 7:30 AM without explicit permission.
- All individuals must wear a face mask to enter the building.
- All students, staff, and visitors are required to be screened via temperature checks before entering.
- Students will enter and exit through one of six marked doors located around the building.
- Parent Drop Off using the front drive will enter through the main entrance.



BREAKFAST PROCEDURES

- Students who wish to eat breakfast should report directly to the cafeteria upon entrance at 7:30 am.
- Breakfast will be a grab-and-go style meal.
- Students must go directly to their first-hour class after obtaining their breakfast.
- All students must proceed directly and immediately to their first-hour class upon entry to the building. (Unless they are procuring breakfast).
- Students will not be allowed the use of hallway lockers.



FACE MASK MANDATES

- All students and staff must wear a face mask that covers their nose and mouth inside the school at all times and while outside when physical distancing is not feasible.
- Masks must meet CHS dress code expectations. If a student violates the dress code, they will be provided with an appropriate mask.
- Students who fail to bring a mask to school will be ushered to the office and provided a mask.
- Students who refuse to wear a mask in the prescribed and appropriate manner may be subject to disciplinary action.

CLASSROOM PROTOCOLS AND ARRANGEMENTS



- All cloth furniture was removed from the classrooms. Students are not allowed to share supplies or materials.
- Students will have assigned seating in every class. All classrooms will have hand sanitizer available.
- Students are expected to go immediately to their assigned seat when entering the classroom.
- Students are required to wear face coverings at all times in the classroom.



RESTROOM AND HALLWAY

- Students will be required to walk on the right-hand side of the hallways.
- Water fountains will be shut off unless they are water bottle fillers.
- Students must sign-out from class to use the restroom.
- Each teacher may allow up to two students at a time to leave the class to use the restroom.



HEALTH ROOMS

- There will be a separate area for students displaying COVID symptoms and waiting to be picked up.
- A separate area will be designated for typical health suite visits.
- Students who register a temperature of 100.4 degrees or more will be placed in a holding room located near the nurses office, but separate from the health room.
